**ORDER**

After consideration of Plaintiffs’ Status Report Regarding Settlement Distribution to Fisher and Property Classes, the Declaration of Genevieve Pierce on behalf of the Settlement Administrator, and related documents, and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Settlement Administrator is directed to:

1. Approve for payment two Property claims verified by the Settlement Administrator after review of the Objections to Notice of Rejected Claims, and deny all remaining Objections to the Notice of Rejected Claims;

2. Pay an additional Variable Claim payment of \$316.83 to claimant D7UAEZFCG3, and deny all remaining objections to the amounts of claim awards;

3. Accept submission, within 30 days of the date of this Order, of late claims from those who, on or before August 1, 2024, have requested permission to submit them (“New Late Claims”);

4. Pay New Late Claims that can be validated by the Settlement Administrator, based on the claim submissions and review of property records or landings records provided by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife for this purpose (“CDFW data”), as applicable;

5. Pay a Supplemental Distribution to all Verified Claimants in each Class, on a pro rata basis, from the funds remaining available for distribution to members of each respective Class;

6. Escheat, to the state of the claimant’s residence or last known address, the amounts of any settlement checks that have not been cashed as of January 31, 2025, or 180 days after issuance, whichever is later;

7. Payment of \$1,461,601.43 to the Settlement Administrator and \$162,604.70 to the Fontana Group for administrative fees and costs incurred to date;

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Class Counsel is directed submit a proposal for distribution of any remaining residual funds within 30 days after completion of the Supplemental Distribution.
